POSITION OVERVIEW: Together with the Animal Care team, the part time Animal Care Specialist will provide quality care of display and education animals as well as maintain and troubleshoot any habitat, aquarium, or life support of the animal collection. This position will be responsible for helping with the cleaning and maintenance of all animal care behind the scenes and display areas.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Food prep and feeding of all animals in the CSC collection
- Maintain all animal care work areas
- Work with a team of animal care specialists to ensure the daily care of all animals in the CSC collection
- Perform water quality testing of aquarium habitats
- Maintain life support systems
- Assist in the care and training of education and display animals
- Other duties as needed.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Possess the following attributes and abilities to:

- Lift 60lbs to waist level;
- Lift up to 20lbs to shoulders and above head;
- Walk/stand for long periods of time;
- Maneuver safely on uneven surfaces or in tight spaces;
- Safely climb ladders;
- Squat, bend, kneel, twist and reach;
- Reach above the shoulders;
- Push and pull large equipment.

- Great time management skills and be able to multitask;

- Excellent customer service and communication skills with staff, other departments and guests;
- High work performance standards to all work related activities;
- Attention to detail on every task. Be a team player by positively supporting team members in our goals;
- The flexibility to work weekends and holidays (required);
