## **POSITION OVERVIEW:**

The Educator teaches participatory science programs, including science nights and assembly presentations, to school groups, homeschool students, and other organizations. Exact work schedule varies week to week but programs are usually Wednesday - Friday, 8:45 AM - 1 PM.

- Work with teachers and CSC staff to ensure quality experiences for students, utilizing good teaching methods and public relations skills.
- Represent CSC in a positive and professional manner.
- Promote CSC and its various offerings to teachers and students.
- Distribute program evaluation forms to teachers and handle administrative paperwork as needed.
- Maintain program materials in a neat and organized fashion.
- Offer suggestions and assist with making improvements in existing programs.
- Teach school and homeschool programs at CSC and Glenn Hilton Park as directed.
- Teach school programs away from CSC, including Science nights and assemblies as directed.
- Assist with school and homeschool program development as needed.
- Develop and instruct professional development workshops as needed.
- Other duties as required.
