## CSC EXHIBIT WALK-THROUGH VISITS

- Days/ Times:** Wednesdays-Fridays between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm
- Group Size:** 10+ students per visit (plus adult leaders) Groups must have one adult for each group of 10 children.
- Cost:** \$14 per participant, plus tax. One adult leader per 10 children receives free admission. Includes a public planetarium show on a seat available basis (current show schedule).






- Days/ Times:** Wednesdays-Fridays available between 10:00 am and 1:00 pm
- Program Length:** 50 minutes.
- Group Size:** Maximum 65 total participants and adult leaders per show, **minimum group size 12\***
- Cost:** Groups must have one adult for each group of 10 children. \$15 per participant, plus tax. Fee includes CSC walk-through. One adult leader per 10 children receives free admission.

# HANDS-ON PROGRAMS

**Rocks, Meteorites, and Fossils! Oh my!** – Are fossils rocks? How does a meteorite differ from a rock? Discover the difference between a rock, a meteorite, and fossil by investigating them up close and personal. **Suitable for grades K – 3rd**

**Make It Move!** – How does a hovercraft float? How do magnets make things move? Experiment with fun, hand-on experiments that show how science can make things move. **Suitable for grades 2nd – 7th**

**Adaptation Sensation** – Meet some of CSC’s live animals up close and learn about the ways that these animals have learned to survive. Help your groups dinosaur survive by using what you’ve learned! **Suitable for grades K – 5th**

**Living Fossils (Lamprey Dissection)** – Dive into this class to discover how an animal that lived with dinosaurs still survives today. Learners will dissect a lamprey to learn about the anatomy, body systems, and evolutionary links of this unique and fascinating creature. An additional fee of \$17.50 + tax per lamprey applies. 2 – 5 participants per lamprey. **Suitable for grades 5th +**

**Program Length:** 50 minutes.  
**Group Size:** 24 youth maximum, **minimum group size 12\***  
**Cost:** \$16 per person, plus tax. Fee includes CSC walk-through and the opportunity for a public planetarium show on a seat available basis.

**Days/ Times:** Mondays–Fridays between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.  
**Program Length:** 50 minutes.  
**Group Size:** 30 youth maximum, **minimum group size 12\***  
**Cost:** \$275\*\* per program plus tax + mileage  
(Mileage charge: current government rate (72.5¢ per mile))
